REGISTRATION:

AWARDS:

Awards will be presented to the winners of the Olympic Round after the Recurve FITA 70m and 60 m Rounds, Compound 50m

round, the Federal and Caribbean Cup finals.

COMPETITION:

The competition will start with an indoor event, a field event, a FITA 70m Round(Seniors / Juniors) and a 60m Round (Masters & Cadets) for Recurve and a 50m Round for Compound will be shot. An Olympic Round will be held in each category for Individuals. Bare bow archers will shoot in all of the events in their categories. The Caribbean Cup Team event will end the championships.

RULES:

The competition will be conducted in accordance with the present World Archery Federation rules.
